Background Information:

- Senate Bill 11, passed by the 89th Texas Legislature, allowed a Texas public school board
 of trustees to take a record vote on a resolution to adopt, by a record vote on a resolution,
 a policy requiring every campus of the district to provide students and employees with an
 opportunity to participate in a period of prayer and reading of the Bible or other religious
 texts on each school day.
- Keller ISD's Board of Trustees passed such a resolution at its September 24, 2025, Regular Meeting.
- With the passage of that resolution, the district has developed a draft of a policy to fulfill in intent of that resolution.
