**Subject:** Consider and possible Board action to approve interlocal agreement amendment one

between El Paso County, Texas and the San Elizario Independent School District-for

school resource officers

**Date:** May 14, 2025

HISTORY: The County of El Paso, Texas and the San Elizario Independent School District entered into an agreement for School Resource Officers. During District School Safety and Security Committee meeting conversations, the topic of having a rifle safe for each school resource officer in each campus has been discussed. The consensus between members was that it would be beneficial that the SRO's have access to their rifles in an expedited manner, in the event of an emergency.

**RATIONALE:** The rationale is that in the event of an emergency requiring the SRO to have access to his rifle, it is quicker and aids in faster response time if the SRO has his rifle in the campus, in a rifle safe that would be installed by the district. The rifle safes would be district property. This is the only item being amended on the agreement.

**BUDGET IMPACT:** The budget impact for the purchase of the five safes does not exceed \$5,000 in total.

**ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION:** The administrative recommendation is to approve the amendment (amendment one) to the interlocal agreement with El Paso County, Texas for School Resource officers which now includes the purchase and installation of rifle safes by the district. The agreement has been reviewed by the district's legal counsel.
