Background Information: Per EFB (LOCAL) and EFB (EXHIBIT), the Board of Trustees will appoint members to the School Library Advisory Council.

Administrative Consideration:

Below is the language from Policy EFB (EXHIBIT), adopted August 12, 2025:

WHEREAS, the SLAC must consist of at least five members, with each member appointed by the Board of Trustees, and with each Trustee appointing an equal number of members; WHEREAS, a majority of the voting members of the SLAC must be persons who are parents of students enrolled in the District and who are not employed by the District; WHEREAS, one of those members of the SLAC shall serve as chair of the council; WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees may also appoint one or more persons to serve as nonvoting members of the SLAC from any of the following groups:

- Classroom teachers employed by the District;
- School counselors certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, employed by the District;
- School administrators employed by the District;
- The business community;
- The clergy.
