BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The District has standardized to Cisco phones and networking system. This purchase includes phones, networking components and installation to provide services to Rodriguez Middle School so that they are in full communication with all areas of the District. Three quotes were obtained. One company was only able to provide the phones needed. Two companies quoted the complete project and it was determined that Netsync Network Solutions was the best value for this project.
