## Good Morning,

We may have found a grant. It will change our focus a bit, but GMP staff members are willing to try it. I have provided what would change and the link to review the Garrett Lee Smith. (Garrett Lee Smith State/Tribal Youth Suicide Prevention and Early Intervention Grant Program)

# Changes:

- Move from k-12 services to 10-24vrs.
- linkage with facilities for follow-up/wraparound care after discharge,
- Provide post-suicide intervention services, care, and information for students who have died by suicide,
- One or Two staff members at BCC to provide services,
- Provide immediate support and information resources to families of youth who are at risk for suicide (brochure?),
- More ASIST and QPR trainings, all staff take the ASIST train the trainers training,
- start trainings from Clinical Support System for Serious Mental Illness, Mental Health, Substance Abuse Prevention, Addiction Technology Transfer Centers,
- Prior written, informed consent is obtained from a parent or legal guardian of an at-risk child before involving the child in a youth suicide early intervention or prevention program
