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


Introducing Energy Print

New Utility Bill Management Service

- Web based service, no local licenses needed
 - Quick access to data from anywhere
- Utility data input managed and performed by Energy Print
 - Improved accuracy
 - Saves district staff measureable time
- 90 day improvement in time from billing to utilizing data
 - Closer to real time analysis and correction of problems
 - Ability to provide reports to staff and the board much sooner
- On-board dashboard, alerts and diagnostic tools
- Ranking of buildings against Energy Star and Energy Print data base

Analysis By Utility Type (12 mo)

Audit Period

Electricity

- Effective rate increased 1% 1
- Consumption increased by 0.1%
- 12% more cooling degree days 1
- Net increase in dollars of \$66,750 1

Natural Gas

- Effective rate decreased by 12%
- Consumption decreased by 27%
- 30% less heating degree days.
- Net decrease in dollars of -\$160,487.

Analysis By Utility Type

Domestic Water

- Domestic effective rate increased 12% 1
- Domestic consumption increased 5% 1
- Domestic net increase in dollars of \$117,297 1

Irrigation Water

- Irrigation effective rate decreased 12%
- Irrigation consumption increased 79% 1
 - Rainfall down 4.7" Jul-Sep over 11.6mil sf = 36,000kGal or \$210k
- Irrigation net increase in dollars of \$194,784 1

Refuse

Net increase in dollars of \$134,449 1







Accomplishments

- BPM Pilot Program Completion
 - Optimized HVAC Unit startup
 - Reduced electric bill demand charges
- Deployment of Energy Print Utility Bill Management Service
 - Replaces outdated in-house software
- RFP in process to finish deploying smart irrigation controls across the district
 - \$117,349 in annual savings
- Energy saving mechanical retrofit in process at Guyer High School
 - \$5,524 in annual savings

Looking Ahead

- Present audit reports to the board three months closer to audit period in 2017
- Issue RFP for outdoor lighting retrofit
 - \$50,718 in annual electric savings
 - \$20,000 one time rebate
- Petition Denton Municipal Utilities to split up Domestic / Irrigation water accounts
- Planning and budgeting for future energy saving retrofits
