Physical Security & Perimeter

- Fencing: All schools except Tonopah have perimeter fencing.
- Window Film: 11 mil security window film with silicone bead

Key Control & Access Management

- New Key System: Completed the Implementation of a District Master.
- District Key Policy: Formalized rules for key distribution and use.
- Key Control: General oversight of physical keys. Key audits
- External Key Access: Knox box keys provided to the Fire Chief and Sheriff's Department.
- Master Access: SROs (School Resource Officers) hold master keys and key cards.
- Interior Locks: All doors can be locked from the inside without a key.
- District Door Lock Policy: Formalized standards for locking doors.

Technology

- Clock Intercoms: District wide plan to standardize communication systems.
- Single Point Entry: Restricting access to one primary entrance.
- Camera Integration: All cameras viewable from anywhere in the district for easy law enforcement access.
- AI Policy: District created an AI policy including guidance on AI glasses.
- IT Collaboration for School Safety: Attended Nevada School Safety workshop with the IT department.

Law Enforcement & Emergency Response

- Shared Intelligence: Sheriff's department/ SROs have school maps.
- 24/7 Response: Sheriff and Fire departments have lists of numbers for after-hours calls.

- Site Familiarity: Allowing the Sheriff's department to utilize schools for training purposes.
- Tabletop Exercises: Full-day training in Pahrump with EOP (Emergency Operations Plan) involving Sheriff, Fire Chief, Cabinet, IT, and Safety/Security department.
- SRO Infrastructure: Designated offices in certain schools with their own independent internet systems.

Training & Professional Development

- Campus Monitor Training: Revamped training and a new Campus Monitor handbook (developed by Jeff Kaye).
- Mental Health Training: Campus monitors attended a day of training for youth mental health and CPR at the coalition.
- Admin Training: A day of training to review the EOP with site administrators.
- Safety Workshops: Attendance at the yearly Nevada School Safety workshop.
- Standardized custodial practices have been implemented across all sites, including the use of Buckeye cleaning chemicals and comprehensive training for all custodians and substitute staff. This training is aligned with the ISSA Clean Standard to ensure consistency and quality.
- Multiple site surveys are conducted each year to evaluate cleanliness and maintenance. The results of these surveys are used to identify areas for improvement and to develop targeted action plans that enhance overall facility conditions.

Committees & Planning

- Development Committee: Revamped to include custodians, teachers, counselors, County Board of Health, Fire Chief, and Sheriff's Department.
- Assessments: Staying current on yearly Hazard Vulnerability Assessments.
- Funding: Utilizing grants to complete suggested safety improvements.
