Some key K-12 issues:

- HB 4082 \$30 million for summer learning (HB 4082)
- SB 1502 Recording and posting school board meetings
- SB 1532 Statewide Immigrant and Refugee Student Success Plan
- SB 1558 Fixes to SB 819 (abbreviated day)
- SB 1552 Omnibus Bill: Oregon Youth Advisory Group; Changes to just cause definition of "classified employee," technical fix to sub pay (for half days or less), and more
- SB 1515 Paid Leave Oregon Technical Changes and Alignment with OFLA

State agencies are working on 2025-27 budget estimates and possible policy needs

- Policy Option Packages get submitted to Governor for potential inclusion in GRB
- Any potential bill requests must be approved through Gov's office
