 - Elementary Science Wednesday meetings we learn about our environment and the world around us through interactive group meetings, experiments, games, and activities
 - Elementary Students have sponsored a Penguin from the MN Zoo as a class pet and we will be learning about the endangered African Penguin in the coming weeks.
 - Several of our students from across grade levels participated in a Loon Center excursion on the Stewardship to learn about the Loons in Crosslake.

- Mrs. Thompson led a group of students to the Long Lake Conservation area to experience the night sky in person.
- We are working to implement high-school-wide activities focused on Global Temperature change in our MESS-E projects. This cross-curricular activity will help students to learn about the Global Temperature change in a variety of ways from several angles.

I would like to make a change to our Professional Development plan. In our MESS-E meetings, a lot of questions came up that made me think that an EE overview was in order. Here is my tentative plan.

- I will create minilessons based on <u>EE K-12 Guide to Excellence.</u> With a short quiz/survey. I am thinking every other month starting in October but that may change when I start digging in deeper.
- If time allows I will follow up with select pieces of the <u>EE Professional Development</u>
 <u>Guidelines</u>. These would be accompanied by a short Goggle survey to see how
 confident staff feel implementing and supporting EE in their roles. It will also offer an
 opportunity to see where we need to focus more training.
- K-8 will still have the field trip discussion time on Nov. 4th and during that same time,
 9-12 will have a short MESS-E overview. (MESS-E overview will be run by the
 MESS-E committee but I think should still count for EE CEU's, thoughts on that?)
