The Duke TIP is a nonprofit organization dedicated to serving gifted and talented students. The Seventh Grade Talent Search identifies bright students based on their standardized test scores achieved while attending elementary. Candidates are invited to take the ACT or SAT college entrance exams as seventh graders, which allows them greater insight into their academic abilities. In addition, they gain valuable benefits and have access to unique resources for gifted students.

Twenty-four of our seventh graders participated in taking the ACT college entrance exam. Of those 24, 8 students scored at or above the state level and will be recognized at State Recognition Ceremony at Trinity University on May 9, 2019. Of those 8, 3 of our students scored at the national level and have been invited to attend the Grand Recognition Ceremony at Duke University in Durham, North Carolina on May 20, 2019. Only the students with the highest scores, top 4%, are invited to the Grand Ceremony.
