

SET Report for 1st quarter 10-11

Harlem High School 9th Grade Campus

Total Offenses:

- There were 265 disciplinary referrals written during the 1st quarter. This is a decrease of 45 referrals compared to the 1st quarter last year.
- There were 108 students who received one or more referrals during the 1st quarter.

Race Report:

- Minority students comprise 17.2% of the student body, (104/604 students).
- During the 1st quarter 20 of the 108 students receiving one or more referrals was a minority student. This is 18.5% of the total students receiving referrals.
- Of the 265 total discipline violations written, 51 were written for minority students. This is 19% of total referrals written.

Free and Reduced Report:

- 59.3% of students are eligible for free or reduced lunch, (358/604 students).
- During the 1st quarter, 69 of the 108 students receiving one or more referrals were eligible for free/reduced lunch. This accounts for 63.8% of the total number of students receiving referrals.
- Of the 265 referrals written, 186 were written for these students which equals 70.2% of the total number of referrals processed.

Special Ed Report:

- There are 81 students at the 9th grade campus receiving special education services. This is approximately 13.4% of the total population (81/604).
- During the 1st quarter, 19 of the 108 students receiving referrals were Special Ed. This accounts for 17.5% of the total number of students receiving referrals.
- Of the 265 referrals written, 71 were written for these students. This accounts for 26.8% of referrals written.

Referred to juvenile Authorities:

- There were 12 students referred to Juvenile Authorities during the 1st term.
- There were 10 male and 2 female students referred, 2 were minority and 10 were white.
- There were 2 referrals for battery, 1 for drug use, 4 for fighting, 2 for bullying/harassment, 2 were for theft/possession of property and 1 for verbal assault to staff.
