Another student new to the district was experiencing problems before enrolling at BISD and is in Tier III of RTI. If no progress is made by early January a referral is likely to be requested. We also expect an admission at an initial ARD tomorrow after recent psychological testing. A referral on the student who's records we were waiting on is being initiated with a request for psychological testing expected in January.

We are currently reviewing data and working on our **Performance Based Monitoring Analysis System** documents that must be ready for submission in early January. Main areas of concern this year are SpEd students in ISS compared to non-SpEd students and SpEd students failing math and science TAKS.
