AGENDA ITEM:	Report Out of the Finance and Audit Committee and Consideration of Approval of No Increase of Tuition Rates and Fees Effective Fall 2025
DISCUSSION:	The recommendation is not to increase tuition and fees for Fall 2025. The Board is committed to providing high- quality education while offering low-cost tuition. Affordable tuition assists student debt concerns, maintains stability in enrollment, and attracts additional students.
DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:	The District President recommends the current tuition rates and fees remain at \$67 per credit hour for in-district residents, \$127 per credit hour for out-of-district residents, and \$202 per credit hour for out-of-state/out-of- country residents, effective Fall 2025. No tuition increase is recommended.
SUGGESTED MOTION:	This item may come as a motion and second out of committee. A suggested motion would be, "Mr. Chairman, I make a motion that the Board of Trustees of Collin County Community College District approves the current tuition rates and fees of \$67 per credit hour for in-district residents, \$127 per credit hour for out-of-district residents, and \$202 per credit hour for out-of-state/out-of-country residents, to remain effective Fall 2025. There will not be an increase in tuition."
