Proposed resolution: TASB advocates for a comprehensive review of charter school policies, transparency, and charter school expansion.

**Statement of reasons:** We support legislation allowing charter innovations benefitting students but expect the same level of transparency and accountability required of all public schools. This would include compliance with all State financial reporting, management, transparency and accountability requirements and standards set forth for all public schools. We also advocate for the removal of all special, additional, and supplemental State funding for both new and existing charter schools that exceeds comparable funding for public schools. And, require charter school applications to identify site-specific locations for all new or existing facilities and dis-allow applications that include multi-county or multi-district "possible" locations.
