

E.2 – New and Unfinished Action Items

E.2.d – Consider Hazardous Route Area for Mineola Primary School

Background

The State of Texas does not require school transportation for students living within two-miles of a campus and does not provide funding. The district has declared students attending Mineola Primary School as living in a hazardous zone if they live east of State Highway 69 and south of Highway 80. The superintendent is asking the board to consider expanding the hazardous zone for Mineola Primary School to include all students.

Recommendation

The superintendent recommends the board approve all students attending Mineola Primary School as living in a hazardous zone due to the fact that there are no side-walks and cross-ways for students attending MPS.
