TOPIC: Approval to Purchase Mobile Devices and Carts – 2013 Bond

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of 4,000 Chromebooks, 100 Chromebook carts, and deployment services for the Chromebooks from Presidio Infrastructure Solutions, Troy, Michigan, for a total amount of \$1,407,100.

RATIONALE:

This purchase is round two of planned purchases of mobile devices for District schools from the technology budget of the 2013 bond fund. Pricing was obtained from the State of Michigan's 22i SPOT Bid, which fulfills the District's purchasing requirements.
