

Superintendent Report

1. Randy's Roofing Service won the contract on re-roofing the administration building. Materials will be delivered the week of March 24th and work will begin the week of March 31th. They will not be working during the mornings of April 1st and 2nd because of STAAR testing at the middle school. The roof will be a 26 gauge Max Rib, Galvalume plus steel roof and will cost \$14,900.00.
2. Mrs. Crow has arranged for Victor Cheatham to speak to the community. Topics will address sexting, bullying, drug paraphernalia, street lingo, energy drinks, social networking, etc. This meeting will be in conjunction with a performance by the high school drama club and a band ensemble. The program is scheduled for Monday, March 31, 2014 at 6:00 in the high school cafeteria.
