
Construction Schedule and Scope of Work March 26, 2009

I. Proposed Scope of Work:


- a. Complete Abatement of Asbestos building material in all campus
- b. Install new vinyl tile flooring at all classrooms
- c. Install new porcelain tile at all hallways and cafeteria
- d. Remodel all student restrooms in Academic Buildings A, B, and C ADA compliance
- e. Replacement of computer lab stations and millwork
- f. ADA upgrades at science labs

II. Proposed Construction Schedule:

- a. May 29, 2009:
 - Relocation of all furniture, equipment, supplies from classrooms in Academic Building B and Administration Area into gym or to new High School
 - Relocation of Administrative staff to new High School
- b. June 2, 2009:
 - New High School Administration Bldg. occupied and begin set-up for operations
 - Access to cafetorium will be closed Asbestos abatement process begins
 - Access to Academic Building B will be closed, asbestos abatement
 - Relocation of all furniture, equipment, supplies from classrooms in Academic Building A, Library, and Music Bldg. into gym or new High School
 - Renovations of restrooms in Bldg. C begins
- c. July 1, 2009:
 - Access to Building A, Library and Music Bldg. will be closed –asbestos abatement
 - Remodeling of Academic Building B, cafeteria, and library begins
 - Technology systems relocations and installations begins in Academic Bldg. B and Administration
 - Renovations of restrooms in Academic Bldg. B begins
- d. Completion Date for all building renovations August 6, 2009
