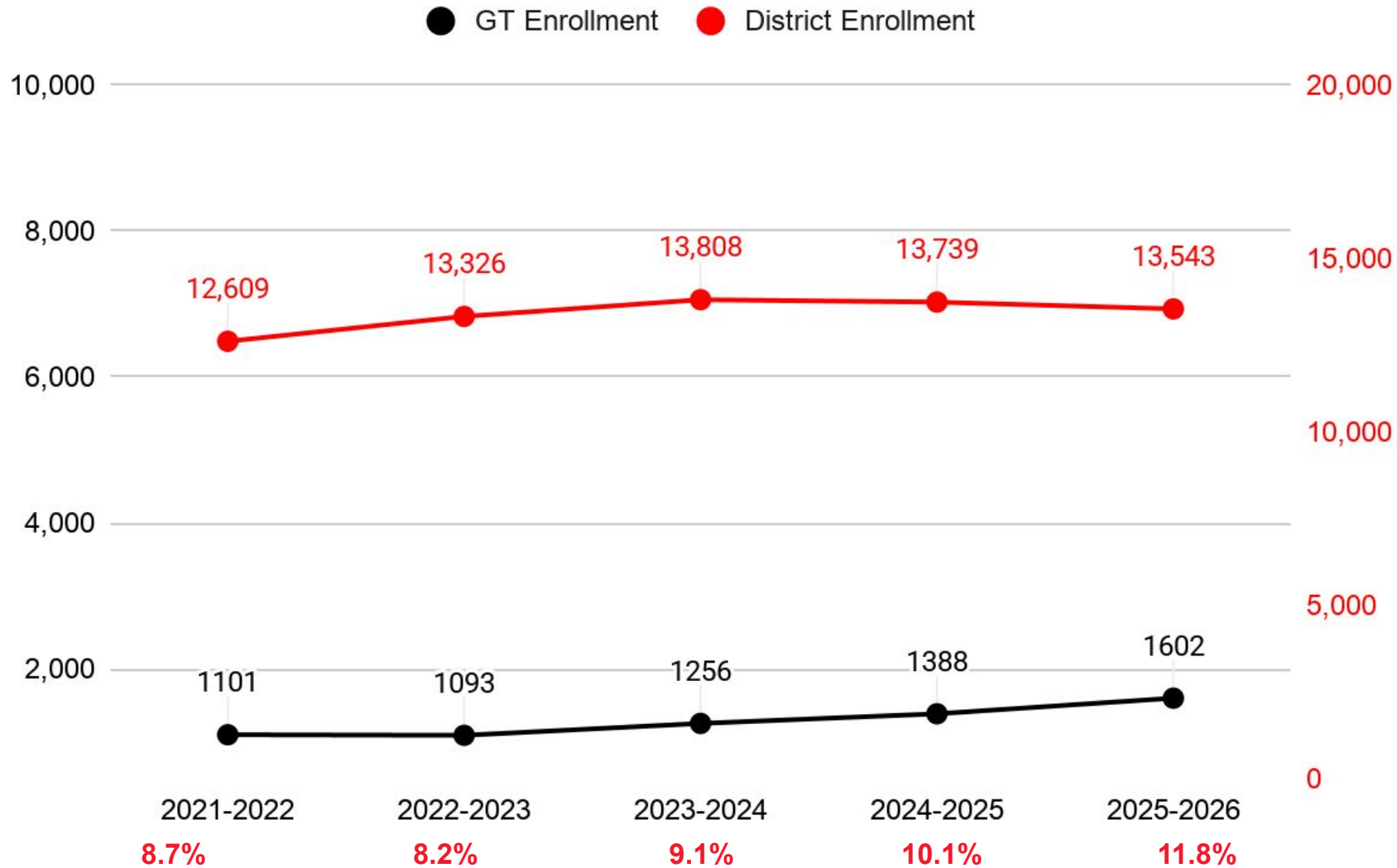

# Five Year Enrollment

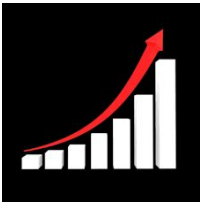

Continued Growth: Belton ISD GT students maintain 83% growth rate in ELAR and math comparable to the region and state.

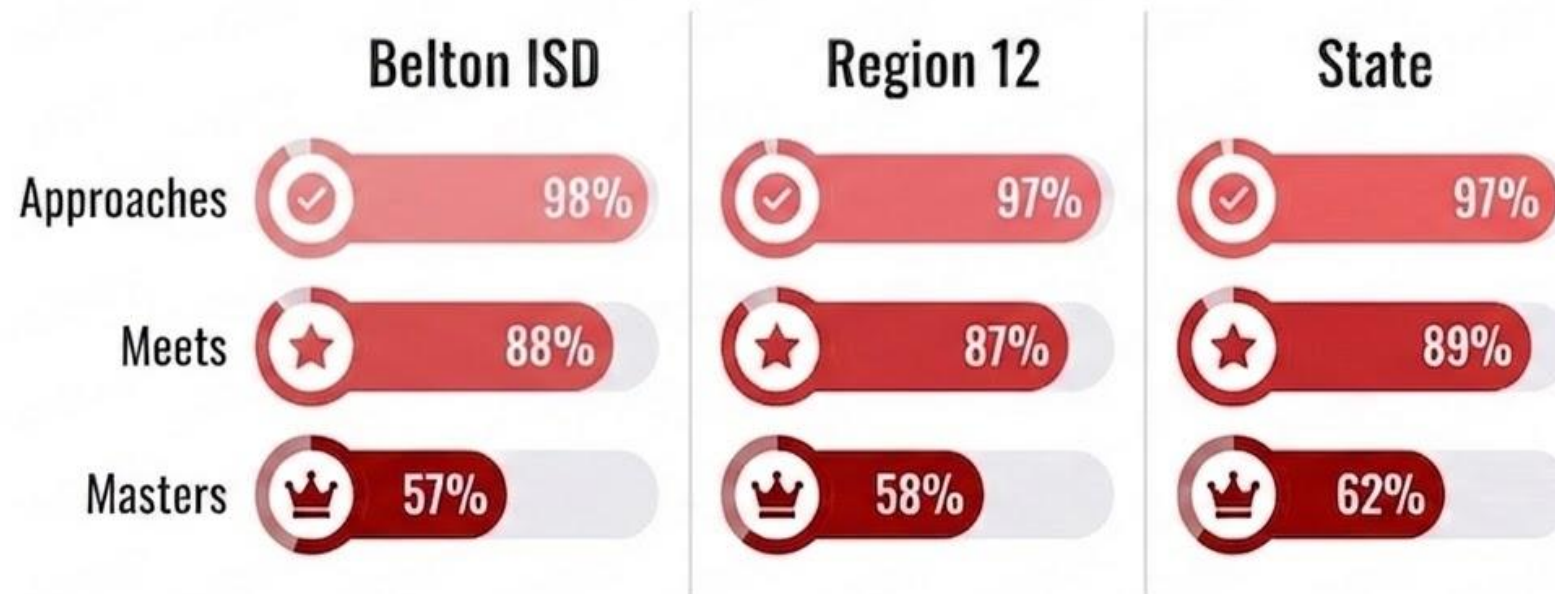


Graduation Success: 100% of GT students graduated in 4 years

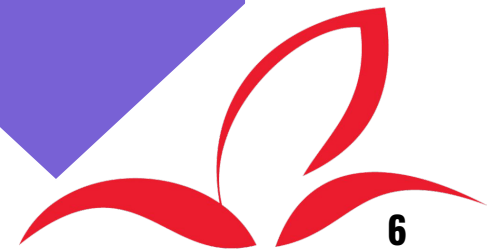

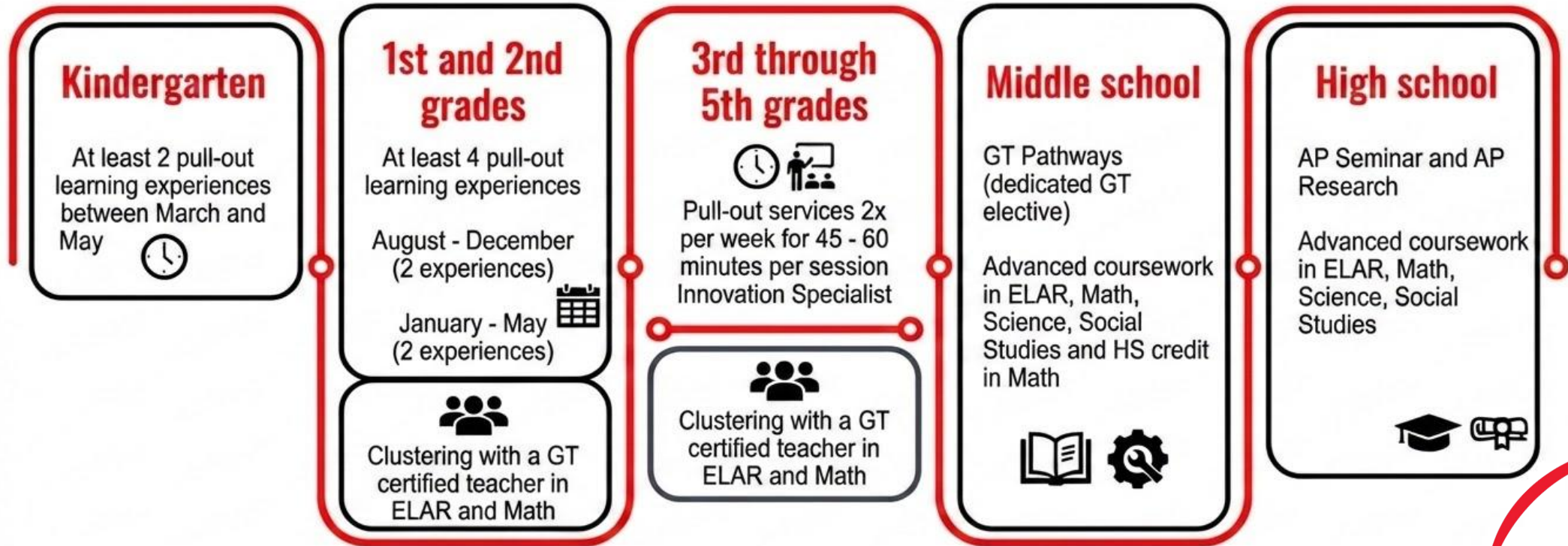

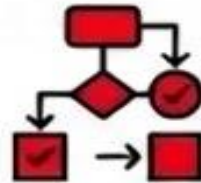
