NSBSD Policy Manual:

BP 3290, Gifts, Grants and Bequests: The School Board greatly appreciates the support of community members and may accept suitable donations on behalf of the district. To be acceptable, a gift, grant or bequest should satisfy the following criteria:

1. Not begin a program that the Board would be unwilling to continue when the donated funds are exhausted;
2. Not entail undesirable or hidden costs, such as additional staff workload;
3. Place no restrictions on the school program;
4. Not be inappropriate or harmful to the best education of students;
5. Not imply endorsement of any business or product;
6. Not conflict with any provision of the board policy or public law;
7. Have a purpose consistent with those of the district.

Issue Summary:

Native Village of Point Lay has donated \$6120 to Kali School in support of the pool re-opening for the employment of the lifeguard. This will be coded to account code 215.460.000.000.040.
