NSBSD Policy Manual:

BP 3290, Gifts, Grants and Bequests: The School Board greatly appreciates the support of community members and may accept suitable donations on behalf of the district. To be acceptable, a gift, grant or bequest should satisfy the following criteria:

- 1. Not begin a program that the Broad would be unwilling to continue when the donated funds are exhausted;
- 2. Not entail undesirable or hidden costs, such as additional staff workload;
- 3. Place no restrictions on the school program;
- 4. Not be inappropriate or harmful to the best education of students;
- 5. Not imply endorsement of any business or product;
- 6. Not conflict with any provision of the board policy or public law;
- 7. Have a purpose consistent with those of the district.
