Subject:

Recommendation to purchase flexible classroom furniture for East Aurora High School.

The Issue:

Replace classroom furniture at East Aurora High School.

Justification:

East Aurora High School has many old and damaged desks throughout the building. The current desks also are desk/chair combinations which do not allow for collaborative learning or utilizing space to move the desks for group activities. Buildings and grounds has worked with building admin to purchase (450) flexible seating/desks and chairs that will be movable, fit together as needed, and allow for cooperative learning groups. This will outfit 15 classrooms. Building and grounds would like to begin to replace old desks on a cycle over the next years as needed.

The purchase would go through a cooperative purchasing agreement in order to spend the money in a timely fashion, as well as receiving the furniture in a short lead time to be used during summer school this summer 2024.

This purchase would be made using Title Funds.

Board Policy and Past Practices:

Pursuant to Board Policy 4:60, Supplies, materials, or work involving an expenditure in excess of \$25,000 must comply with the State law bidding procedure, 105 ILCS 5/10-20.21, unless specifically exempted including (XV), State master contracts authorized under Article 28A of this Code.

We look forward to a long and successful partnership underneath this contract.


