Agenda Item: Consider Approval of the MOU with TVCC for the Dual Credit Program

Summary:

Each year the TISD and TVCC enter into a partnership agreement to provide dual credit courses for students at Terrell High School. These include core content classes as well as those in CTE. Providing these courses allows our students to graduate with credits that transfer to four-year universities. The agreement provides the opportunity for TISD students to graduate with an Associate's Degree.

The FAST program provides funding to colleges and other public institutions so they can offer dual credit courses to educationally disadvantaged students at no cost to these students. By statute, the FAST program requires that eligible students at participating institutions incur no cost for their dual credit coursework. An eligible student will not pay tuition and fees for an eligible dual credit course. Books, supplies, and other course materials must also be provided at no cost to an eligible student.

The DC Dual Credit Welding Partnership Agreement 2026-2027 allows Terrell ISD to partner with TVCC for students to enroll in dual credit welding courses and complete the Arc Welding Program at THS. As part of the program transition, TVCC provided payment of up to \$ 75,000 year one (2024-2025), and \$75,000 year two (2025-2026) for the instructor salary. In years three (2026-2027), four (2027-2028), and five (2028-2029) Terrell ISD will be responsible for the Terrell ISD Welding instructor's salary.

Additional appendices to the MOU include the TVCC Guide for Potential Dual Credit Courses and the TVCC Israeli Boycott Agreement.

The TVCC Dual Credit Sponsorship Payment Agreements 2026-2027 outlines the fee structure for dual credit courses and authorizes TISD to provide payment of services when invoiced.
