Winter sports are here. Girls basketball starts today, November 3rd. In their preseason meeting they had 24 girls in attendance. Not sure yet if we will have two or three teams. Boys basketball will start on Monday, November 17th. Wrestling is also scheduled to start on Monday, November 17th.

Volleyball Update-

Volleyball's season ended at the district tourney in Weiser. The girls varsity finished the season with a 9-12 overall record and a 5-7 SRV record. The girls were very competitive this year in a very difficult conference. Fruitland ended up being the state champions and Cole Valley finished 3rd at state. Coach Nash is doing a great job promoting youth volleyball in the community. All of her hard work will start to pay off, I am confident in that.
