Background Information:

The **Texas Racial Profiling Report** is an annual, statewide summary required by **Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 2.132**, which mandates that law enforcement agencies collect and report data on traffic and pedestrian stops. The report, compiled by the **Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE)**, analyzes information such as the race or ethnicity of individuals stopped, reasons for stops, searches conducted, contraband found, citations or arrests made, and use of force. Its purpose is to promote transparency, monitor potential racial or ethnic bias in policing, ensure compliance with state law, and provide policymakers and the public with data to evaluate law enforcement practices across Texas.
