"DOI" legislation gives traditional ISDs the flexibilities available to charter schools such as:

- instructional minutes
- minimum attendance
- school start date
- governance
- certification
- appraisal system
- etc.





Are there any laws a district cannot choose to be exempt?

YES! An ISD cannot be exempt from rules such as:

- elected boards of trustees
- powers and duties of school boards, superintendents, and principals
- **PEIMS**
- BE/ESL/SPED/PK · and a few others

- curriculum and graduation requirements
- academic accountability
 - other state and federal laws outside of TEC

How is Denton ISD going about the DOI process?



Every campus has a teacher rep; and there are also administrators, parents, business and community reps as well.



Because no new monies are involved, the challenge is to think "inside the box."



The DOI Committee has been meeting to identify barriers to student achievement and/or local control.



Thus far, the committee has identified the following barriers:

- school start date
- certification (related to CTE courses only (i.e. a welder to teach welding)
- 90% attendance rule
- class size



Currently, Denton ISD practices a class size ratio of 22:1 in K - 2 and 24:1 in 3 - 4. Waivers are filed with TEA for classes that exceed the 22:1 cap.

Will the district start filling K - 4th Grade classes with 30+ students?



No. Nothing will change from current practice other than the requirement of staff filling out more paperwork with TEA.






So, no more attendance rules for students?

DISTRICT OF INNOVATION PLAN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

Under the Texas Education Code Chapter 12A: Districts of Innovation, Denton ISD has identified the following requirements imposed by the Texas Education Code that inhibit the goals of the Denton ISD Innovation Plan:

1. First day of instruction

Currently:

A school district may not begin instruction for students for a school year before the fourth Monday in August.


