We are a year from required implementation of Common Core Standards, Tier 1 of PBIS, RtI, Smarter Balance Assessment, Teacher Effectiveness, Student Learning Objectives, and Special Education Specific Learning Disabilities Law. Focus on these topics is important, and we worked on presenting a continuing education that is effective, consolidating and incorporating ideas and ideals of each initiative into a working model that can be used practically in the classroom.

Topics of Interest and Urgency: Our missions for the year will be District-wide in nature and will connect us continually through the year.

Common Core Standards will be widely implemented in a variety of ways and by all licensed staff. We will work under the umbrella of Core Curriculum to address the standards of all content area. "Strengthening our Core" will be the focus in curriculum and PBIS all year long.

We will need to make time to address Second Language Learners, Title 3, and ELL, as this is quickly becoming our reality in successful education.

PBIS and Rtl will be ongoing, continuous, reflective, and will progress forward through each inservice.

ATLAS training--Time to be sure all are set up with the tools: The expectation for ATLAS--By the end of 2013-14 Academic year, when teachers leave at the end of the year, ATLAS is updated and complete in its curriculum. We need to go through the Common Core standards and get units aligned to standards and into ATLAS in tandem with "I CAN" statements in reading in math. (Outcome = Activity= Assessment triangle) There is a lot of work to be done in terms of documenting what we will be (and are) teaching, with priority focus on math and reading.

Reading and Math...then Science...then Social Studies...

For constructing the "I CAN" statements, strategies and training include using previous examples and collaborative efforts.
