**TOPIC:                   Approval of Bid Results for Security Cameras**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District accept the recommendation from the Owner's Representative, Plante Moran Cresa, to approve the purchase and installation of security cameras, including licensing for ten years, from Sentinel Technologies, Chicago, Illinois, in the amount of \$1,890,542.66, which includes contingency.

**RATIONALE:**

This purchase will replace security cameras and provide additional security camera coverage, both interior and exterior, to all buildings in the District and allow for cloud storage of any saved footage. This is a planned Bond project.
