BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Legislative Update: Implementation of Education-Related Bills

During the 89th Texas Legislative Session, nearly 200 education-related bills were signed into law by Governor Abbott. Many of these new laws are scheduled to take effect on **September 1, 2025**, with several requiring **formal policy adoption** by the **Board of Trustees** prior to the start of the new school year.

Additionally, some legislation requires **Commissioner's Rules** from the Texas Education Agency (TEA) to guide implementation. As such, districts across the state — including Argyle ISD — are in a "wait and prepare" phase as we anticipate further **guidance**, **rulemaking**, **and updates** throughout the school year.

The bills highlighted in this presentation represent those that either **require Board attention and action** before the first day of instruction or **present important legal changes** for community awareness. We appreciate your continued partnership as we navigate these significant and evolving changes.
