Previous Recommendations Discussed at 2/22 BOE Meeting

It is highly unlikely we would agree on an initial recommendation, however, I thought I would make a suggestion for the BOE to use as a starting point for discussion. Collective power comes from uniting under a "shared" mission/vision statement. When we discuss this at an upcoming Board meeting, please come prepared to share your initial reaction to the proposed changes and what you would recommend changing. Or do you have an altogether different recommendation?

I would suggest we simplify our core messaging and reduce to two items:

- 1. Our Mission
- 2. Five Strategic Focus Areas

Eliminating the Purpose and Guiding Principle reduces redundancy and improves the odds of better recall of our Mission statement.

I suggest we incorporate words into our Mission statement which reflect both our seat-based and online programs. Below are a few thought-starter statements.

Additionally, the BOE liked the recommendation of consolidation and less wording. The BOE seemed comfortable eliminating the Purpose and Guiding Principle. Comments included that we should include our focus on small group settings since our school has evolved it made sense to reflect both of our learning programs in our mission.
