

High School Board Report May 11, 2020

Our staff continues to work diligently providing lessons for students, conducting Zoom meetings, providing academic feedback, and communicating with parents and students.

We appreciate all the positive messages and support from our students and community that we have received during this crisis. It is GREAT to be a Wylie Bulldog!!

On April 27th and 28th, six students from Wylie High School competed in the Virtual Region 14 Texas Citizen Bee competition. The topics covered the Constitution and Founding Documents, Famous American Figures, Landmark Court Cases, and Current Events. Our students won a combined \$400 in gift cards. Daniel Duke won 1st place with a \$250 Gift Card. Daniel will move on to the State Citizen Bee competition.

Our UIL academic teams participated in a virtual meet against participants from all over the state. 5A Calculator-2nd Place Team. We had 7 students to finish in the top 16.

5A Mathematics-1st Place Team. Ayden Gertiser was champion. Team members finished 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 10th.

5A Number Sense-1st Place Team- Ayden Gertiser was champion. Team members finished 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 9th, 15th, and 17th.

5A Science-2nd Place Team- Rushil Choutapalli was overall champion.

The Wylie Belle and Wylie Cheerleading tryouts were conducted virtually over the past two weeks. Candidates submitted videos via unlisted links on YouTube and judges from different parts of the state judged the candidates. We are excited that each team has grown with qualified candidates allowing for more students to be involved and take leadership roles within the campus.

Athletics- Coaches are continuing to work with our student athletes through Zoom and Huddle. They are having good participation from the students.

The high school administration is currently working on a virtual recognition for the graduating seniors in conjunction with KTXS. The release date is TBD.
