Academics

- 396 students are currently enrolled, with 2 new enrollments in the last week.
- 51 students are enrolled in IDLA.
- Ms. Lilienkamp, Ms. Meyn, and Mrs. Haggett attended IDLA training in Coeur D'Alene on September 24.
- Mrs. Haggett is attending the Danielson Recertification Training 10/8 and 10/9
- Mr. T Hansen is attending the Idaho Principals Network in Boise 10/16 and 10/17
- Mr. England has the Agoge Cafe running during lunch. It is staffed by middle school students.
- Ms. Meyn's Journalism class is producing a school newsletter.
- The Math Department is participating in the Math Badging Project, which allows students to demonstrate their understanding in real world scenarios.
- The Social Studies Department is developing a benchmark assessment, which will track essential standards across grade levels.
- The English Department is using IXL and written assessment data to determine which students need RTI support.
