The school board should discuss potential areas for the 2017-18 school year. The top stakeholder ideas, sorted by exit outcome areas and the history and status of school board goals since 2012 are attached.

The possible goal areas discussed by the school board last month are:

- I. "Expanding the knowledge base of parents and students about post secondary opportunities". High School Principal Sandy Logrono and Assistant Principal Mark Kolbinger will provide a presentation at the meeting to overview our current programming in this area.
- II. "Develop an age appropriate mental health delivery model in each school." This goal is recommended by the administration after consulting with the TRAK team and mental health professionals from CentraCare and Central Minnesota Mental Health.
- III. Grades 1-8, 10 and 11 will increase achievement by a positive Z Score in reading and math comparing the actual to expected growth as determined by testing in the Fall of 2016 for NWEA to the Spring of 2017 and Spring of 2016 to Spring of 2017 for MCA.
