Good afternoon Dr. Woods:

I hope that this email finds you well. I want to send you a short update regarding the Nia, Parent Mentor Program. First, I have not received any reimbursements yet for the expenses that the program has incurred since beginning in August. In the past, reimbursements started in September and continued monthly until July. This year they are behind for some reason. I have submitted over \$30,000 worth of expenses and am told that payment will be sent in December. The delay has been on the state level from what I understand. I have only made one payment of \$2,000 toward the \$20,000 loan you and the district approved. As soon as I receive the remainder, I will write RCS a check for the \$18,000 and deliver it to Mrs. Flores.

Good News, we have almost all 24 potential mentors background checked and starting in their respective classrooms. A few have also applied for paraprofessional positions already. We share with them the opportunity during their initial week of training. I had hoped that they would have waited until they were grounded in the program and comfortable with the routine before applying, I guess some are anxious to be of help. Good news nonetheless.

Great News, the program has been approved and funded to add Northview School to the program. I have already discussed it with Principal Kelly Mahoney and her staff and begun recruiting mentors and one coordinator for the new Northview cohort. It's exciting to know that we will be able to work alongside all the schools in the district to help children and families succeed.

I promised a short update, so I will end here. I have more to share about potential programming but will save it for a later time.

**PARENT MENTOR PROGRAM (PMP)
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)**

This PMP Agreement (Agreement) is made and entered into as of July 27, 2023 by and between Rantoul City Schools #137 (RCS) and Nia Incorporated (Nia), a Not For Profit operating in accordance with the laws of the state of Illinois, with RCS and Nia collectively referred to herein individually as a “Party” and collectively as the “Parties”. This document creates a memorandum of understanding for the purpose of providing services benefiting RCS through Nia.

Through this MOU, the Parties establish a contractual partnership through which Nia will provide a PMP and RCS will provide an initial “line of credit” to Nia in the amount of \$20,000.

Nia will appoint a person to serve as the official contact and coordinate the activities of the PMP in carrying out this MOU. Samuel Hall, III, Executive Director of Nia, Incorporated NFP will serve as the official contact and coordinate the activities. Nia will perform the duties of administrative agent, including fiscal management, staff hiring and training, contractual agreements to achieve the program goals and operate a high-quality, evidence-based program for all stakeholders.

RCS will provide Nia a line of credit, loan or grant in the amount of \$20,000 in order to be used for program expenditures, on or before August 15, 2023. Nia, will pay back the line of credit or loan, once funds are received from the grantor, Southwest Organizing Project, on or before December 31, 2023.

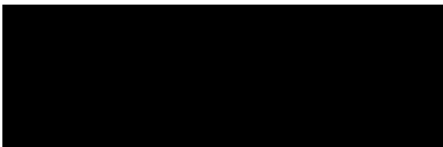

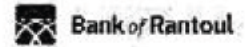
