BACKGROUND/CONSIDERATIONS:

Section 7.13 of the District policies allows the Superintendent to submit a list of surplus commodities to the Board for authorization to sell such surplus commodities. These commodities (attached) are requested to be auctioned to the general public on a tentative date of December 17, 2020.

Commodities not sold are considered to have no fair market value and will be disposed of by the District.

RECOMMENDATION:
