Purpose of Report

This Workshop submitted to the Board of Trustees will reflect many of the objectives the Child Nutrition Program has accomplished during the 2019-2020 school year.

<u>Objectives</u>

- Provide an overview of the implications of increased participation and outcomes for the current school year.
- Discuss the impact of Pre-K and Universal Free Breakfast programs.
- Share training objectives that impacted employee engagement.
- Outline future projects for continued growth in population and participation.

Operational Impact

The expansion of Pre-K and Universal Free Breakfast increased the number of students eating breakfast by 23% up an average of 1,300 students a day. Universal free breakfast is offered at the following campus locations: Alexander ES, Borman ES, Evers Park ES, Ginnings ES, Hodge ES and Rivera ES. Training continues as a primary goal for all Child Nutrition staff, we completed several corporate trainings including True Colors, Gallop Strengths and ServSafe Food Safety. The funds generated by Child Nutrition are returned to the operation through improvements in equipment and updates to facilities. We have added 2nd lines to all Universal Free locations, painted several locations and have an update in progress at Braswell High School.
