SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:

As mandated by IDEA, we are required to provide the minimum amount of service time identified on IEP's and service plans for students currently enrolled in our district and for students who qualify for Speech and Language services and attend a public or private school within the Southfield boundaries.

COST BENEFIT ANALYSIS: Maintaining compliance will support student success as we address the learning gap and improve outcomes for students with disabilities. The district will reduce the risk of having to provide compensatory services and or financial sanctions from the Michigan Department of Education and federal monitors.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Superintendent recommends continuing our partnership with AnthroMed as we strive to deliver high-quality programs and services for students with disabilities.

IMPACT IF NOT APPROVED:

Southfield Public Schools will be found non-compliant to both state and federal regulations that mandate services are provided as outline in the IEP and service plans.
