Recommendation:

The administration recommends the approval of our district's 25-26 application to the Texas Education Agency for participation in the Optional Flexible School Day Program.

Summary:

The Optional Flexible School Day Program (OFSDP) allows districts to provide flexible hours and days of attendance for students who meet at least one of the requirements of the Texas Education Code §29.0822(a). The goal of the program is to improve graduation rates for students who are in danger of dropping out of school, have dropped out, or are behind in core subject courses.

Eligibility / Criteria for application are listed below:

- The student is at risk of dropping out of school, as defined by the TEC, §29.081;
- The student, as a result of attendance requirements under the TEC, §25.092, will be denied credit for one or more classes in which the student has been enrolled;
- The student is attending a campus with an approved early college high school program designation;
- The student is attending a campus implementing an approved innovative campus plan; or the student is attending a community-based dropout recovery education program, as defined by the TEC, § 29.081 (e-1) or (e-2).

Rationale:

OFSDP allows flexibility for our students and staff in the Academy. These students currently attend the same hours as our traditional campuses. OFSDP would allow students to attend with a flexible schedule that would meet their individual needs. For example, a student may need to attend 8-12 because of work obligations. OFSDP allows the student to receive credit and BISD to collect ADA by the student accumulating time.
