IVHS SUMMER SCHOOL 2016 Classes will be held at ILLINOIS VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL



June 27 – July 21 Monday -Thursday 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM (With the exception of the week of July 4th. Classes will run Tuesday – Friday that week.)

Breakfast and Lunch served- free of cost and straight-line busing provided (Pick-up and Drop-off times available prior to the start of Summer School)

PURPOSE:

Credit recovery for Math, Science, English. Students must have taken the class previously and failed it.

5th year seniors may work on other classes.

HOW MANY CREDITS CAN BE EARNED?

Up to 1.0 credit (**two classes**) for credit recovery. Students must be there every day for the full time and work hard to complete that much credit. Most students will only be able to complete one class and earn $\frac{1}{2}$ a credit.

IF STUDENTS EARN an incomplete in Math/English, they will be automatically enrolled into summer school until this work is complete.

WHAT ARE THE CLASSES LIKE?

Math and English classes will be held in a classroom setting. Science, Social Studies, and Elective classes will be taken online – through OdysseyWare. Students will work individually on the computer to complete these classes. There will be support available from Highly Qualified Teachers and support staff.

SUBJECTS:

Core subjects will be available during summer school (English, Math, and Science). IF you are not sure which classes you need, please contact the IVHS counseling center.

Call or walk in to IVHS Health Center or your regular doctor's office today. If you wait until daily doubles you could be unable to start practice on time.

It is affordable: We can bill your insurance for a well-exam/sports physical at no cost to you except a possible co pay and you receive a \$15 gift card for Taylor's. No insurance no problem: It is a \$25 charge for a sports physical or you might qualify for a sliding scale.
