TITLE: Approval of Children's Internet Protection Act Certification

BACKGROUND:

E-Rate applicants must enforce a policy of Internet safety and certify compliance the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) to be eligible for discounts. CIPA was signed into law on December 21, 2000. To receive support for Internet Access, Internal Connections, and Basic Maintenance services from the Universal Service Fund, school districts must certify that they are enforcing a policy of Internet safety that includes measures to block or filter Internet access for both minors and adults to certain visual depictions.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the recommendation of the Administration that the Governing Board authorize the Superintendent to execute the attached CIPA Certification for submission to the Arizona Department of Education.
