1. The administration is again recommending no increase to our student fees. Also, based upon feedback from the Board we are removing the \$30 dollar Bowling fee.
2. The last time any fees were increased was in FY19 when parking fees were increased from \$125 to \$150. In the last two years total student fees have been reduced by \$85 dollars.
3. The \$30 activity fee was discontinued last year, the \$25 dollar technology fee has been phased out as chrome books for each class has been phased in, and this year the Board is removing the \$30 dollar bowling fee.
