Board Goals for 2023-2028

- Goal 1*:** The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 49% to 60% by June 2024, 65% for 2024-2025, 70% for 2025-2026, 75% for 2026-2027, 80% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**
- Goal 2*:** Increased overall student performance in mathematics to 85% Meets Standard by 2028. The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 53% to 65% by June 2024, 70% for 2024-2025, 75% for 2025-2026, 80% for 2026-2027, 85% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**
- Goal 3*:**The percentage of graduates that meet the criteria for CCMR will increase from 72% to 88% by August 2024 and increase to 95% by 2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**

Summary:

In advance of the 2025 Delegate Assembly, the Board selects a delegate and alternate to serve. Any Board member may serve in this capacity unless he or

she is also a member of the TASB Board.

Background Information:

Annually, the Texas Association of School Administrators (TASA) and the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) hold a joint convention.

TASB will hold the Delegate Assembly on Friday, October 9 in Houston, in conjunction with txEDCON. The TASB Delegate Assembly is where all members have a voice in the overall direction of the organization — from electing who will serve on the TASB Board to approving the education issues that will be included in the TASB Advocacy Agenda. As an Active Member of TASB, the board has the exclusive right to have a voting Delegate at the Assembly. The Navarro ISD Delegate will be the voice for the board at the Assembly, ensuring the priorities for the district and community are reflected in TASB's work. The Board may select a second trustee to serve as an Alternate. Starting this year, both representatives are allowed on the Assembly floor to ensure your board's voting privileges are covered. There is no cost to attend the delegate assembly and complimentary lunch is provided. Registration opens June 21 as part of the txEDCON registration.
