P.7 Volunteers

When volunteering as a chaperone or supervisor for a school sponsored event, volunteers may not bring other children to the event unless prior permission is granted by the principal.

P.12 Engaging in any kind of aggressive behavior that causes, attempts, or risks physical or psychological harm to another or any urging of other students to engage in such conduct. Prohibited conduct includes any use of violence, force, noise, coercion, threats, intimidation, fear, harassment, bullying, *inciting others to misconduct*, hazing or other comparable conduct.

P. 22 <u>STUDENT DRESS AND HYGIENE</u>

It is the obligation of parents and students to see that reasonable and proper dress and appearance be maintained at all times in school and at school activities. No headdress is to be worn in the building, i.e. hats, bandanas, etc. Sunglasses are not to be worn in the building unless prescribed by a physician. Shoes must be worn. Appropriate dress is expected for cold weather recess participation. Clothing *or accessories* depicting drugs, alcohol, tobacco, *violent or threatening images, and/or gore, that impede the ability to fully access learning (ex. fake nails), or reveal an excess of skin* judged by the principal to be inappropriate will not be permitted.
