

Child Abuse Investigations Conducted on School Premises

Any investigation of child abuse will be directed by the Oregon Department of Human Services or law enforcement officials as required by law. When an administrator is notified that the Department of Human Services or law enforcement would like to interview a student at school, the administrator must request that the investigating official provide the information below. Failure to meet one of the five criteria may result in the administrator’s refusal to allow the student interview on school property.
