Background Information:

- The agreement with the Tarrant County Elections Administrator is for services and materials relating to the running of the May 3, 2025, Trustee election, including early voting, voting day and any necessary post-election work.
- The cost estimate to Keller ISD for these services is \$60,847.45. This is an increase of \$31,498.17 from the 2024 election cost as Tarrant County previously charged us based on a shared allocation of costs with other participating authorities derived from the average cost per Election Day polling site. Tarrant County will now charge us based on a shared allocation of costs derived from the number of registered voters (119,885) in our jurisdiction.
