Good Things at PHS:

The new schedule has been smoothly implemented for the second semester.

The credit recovery program is up and running. We have had several conversations with appreciative parents who expressed their gratitude for the program.

Mr. Cothorn's physics class completed a mousetrap car in the physics lab using the 3D printers. The students designed the cars themselves, printed them on the 3D printers and held races to determine the fastest car and which car would travel the farthest.

We continue to collaborate with the teachers to organize the implementation of the Rtl program at the high school. We are considering the following topics as we discuss the program: selection of students, progress monitoring, possible interventions, potential Rtl software, Rtl Instructors and content experts, motivation and accountability of students and requirements to graduate from the program. We are also discussing the priorities for students who qualify for Rtl, credit recovery and potentially Title 1.

CKH at the high school is moving forward. After the Process Champions received professional development on January 3rd we decided to split the faculty into smaller cohorts. Each cohort is led by one of the process champions. The hope is that the smaller groups will facilitate more discussion and sharing of ideas. In the first cohort meeting it was apparent the high school teachers are doing many components of CKH and they are building relationships with students. They are just not using the CKH terminology. Our focus is going to be on building that consistency as we continue to meet and share ideas.
