Looks likely that something will pass but may need to override a possible veto. A lot of talk about putting extra funding in the base so not a one-time funding increment. Much of the conversation surrounded this essential funding element.

Deering school needs and coordination with DOT on the road and DEC on water and



sewer. \$10 million would help get the gravel pad in while DOT is already on the work site saving money. DEC reports that Deering didn't get IHS funding, it was one point short. ANTHC is putting in the application. The sewer and water piping will not be covered by HIS will need to try for EPA funding.

Discussed other capital infrastructure needs for the school district, fire suppression systems.

Highlighted the work of ATC and STAR of the North and need foe increased residential funding.

Highlighted successful grants the NWABSD has received.

Thanked representatives for last year's funding including capital funding but. Noted the struggle to find matching funds.

Addressed need for language and cultural components in school.
