BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Corpus Christi Regional Day School for the Deaf (CCRDSPD) services students ages 0 to 21 at its centralized sites in Corpus Christi and offers Itinerant support to students residing in 38 school districts in Region 2.

Parents, private or public school personnel, or any other person involved in the care or education of a student may refer a student who is suspected of having an auditory impairment to the RDSPD. Referrals may be made by Corpus Christi ISD (CCISD) teachers or staff. Other Referrals outside of CCISD can be requested in writing or by telephone to the Corpus Christi Special Education office or any of the Region 2 member districts.

In order to receive services from Regional Day School Program for the Deaf (RDSPD), a student (0-21 years) must meet the following criteria:

- Have a hearing loss confirmed by reports from a certified audiologist and an otolaryngologist (ENT)
- Hearing loss must impair his or her ability to process linguistic information and have a negative impact on academic performance as determined through a communication evaluation administered by a certified teacher of the deaf. The Full, Individual Evaluation, including communication assessment must be a multidisciplinary assessment conducted by ECI or the student's local school district.
