**TOPIC: Approval to Purchase Replacement of Internet Content Filtering System** 

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education approve the recommendation to purchase the replacement Internet Content Filtering System from iboss Cybersecurity, Inc., San Diego, California. The purchase includes new filtering hardware at a cost of \$17,894.00, a five-year hardware replacement warranty at a cost of \$1,995.00, a five-year filtering software subscription at a cost of \$28,311.90, and shipping costs of \$159.90 for a total cost of \$48,360.80.

### **RATIONALE:**

The district's current Internet content filtering system contract is expiring August 1, 2015. Wayne RESA, in partnership with the state of Michigan, has identified new filtering solutions. The recommendation is to purchase the filtering hardware, three-year hardware replacement warranty and three year software subscription through iboss Cybersecurity, Inc., one of the filtering solutions approved through Wayne RESA.
