MINNEAPOLIS, MN 55343-9108 We recommend that the Duluth Public Schools award a foodservice equipment contract to

Hockenbergs Foodservice Equipment & Supply for the amount of \$2,236,930.49. This work would include five buildings for which construction bids have already been received for the amounts listed on the following page.

Bids from five qualified contractors were received for nine remaining buildings with foodservice work on October 26, 2009. All bids were relatively close indicating bidders had a good understanding of the documents. The bids were itemized giving us the ability to review the bids for potential errors and none were found. Hockenbergs Foodservice Equipment was the low bidder and their bid was below our final cost estimate. Hockenbergs has completed several similar projects specified by our firm including recent work for the Edina Public Schools. Their work has been of good quality, well coordinated and completed in a timely fashion. Seeing no errors or inconsistencies in their bid, we recommend that the District make the award to Hockenbergs for the five projects now ready to proceed.

Hockenbergs foodservice equipment bids for the four buildings for which construction bids will be received in upcoming months are also listed on the following summary page along with the amount to do additional work at the Eastern Middle School site. It is our hope that these projects would also be awarded to Hockenbergs in the near future as they have held their bids for an extended period of time and have given us and JCI assurances that they would continue to do so. This would simplify the coordination of construction throughout the District. It would also make warranty work, maintenance and operation of the foodservice equipment much easier as there would be one point of contact for all buildings.

If bids of the final construction projects come in at a level that makes it necessary to reduce the costs for these projects, we will work closely with the District and JCI to seek opportunities to reduce foodservice equipment costs as well. The District can be assured of getting fair value for any deducts by utilizing the itemized pricing provided in Hockenbergs bid.

The Foodservice Department would also like the opportunity to provide Eastern Middle School with a serving area and separated dining room that are more consistent with peer facilities throughout the state and similar to the serving area planned for the Western Middle School. An add alternate was included in the bids for this work and the District has the opportunity to accept this work at a later date as well.
